JOB DESCRIPTION

EVENING STABLES

REPORTS TO: Barn Manager

COMMITMENT REQUIRED:

- Approximately 2 hours, 1 day a week
- Time to change with the season and lesson schedule

PREREQUISITES:

- Comfortable with horses
- Familiar with signs of health in horses
- Able to recognize different feeds (including hays)
- Able to read
- Physically fit
- Responsible
- Willing to learn
- Able to take direction
- Able to work unsupervised

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Primary responsibility is to perform evening chores including:

- Check board for special instructions
- Check fences
- Feed
- Ensure horses have clean water
- Pick manure in paddocks
- Put on and take off horse clothing (blankets, fly masks etc.)
- Check horses for health status and injuries and take appropriate action
- Clean and tidy barn, hat and belt room, stable yard
- Ensure tack room is locked
- Log activities
- Report problems IMMEDIATELY
- Give as much advance notice as possible if you must miss a shift as the horses still have to be looked after and arrangements will need to be made to replace you.
- Other duties as required
